# Display Description

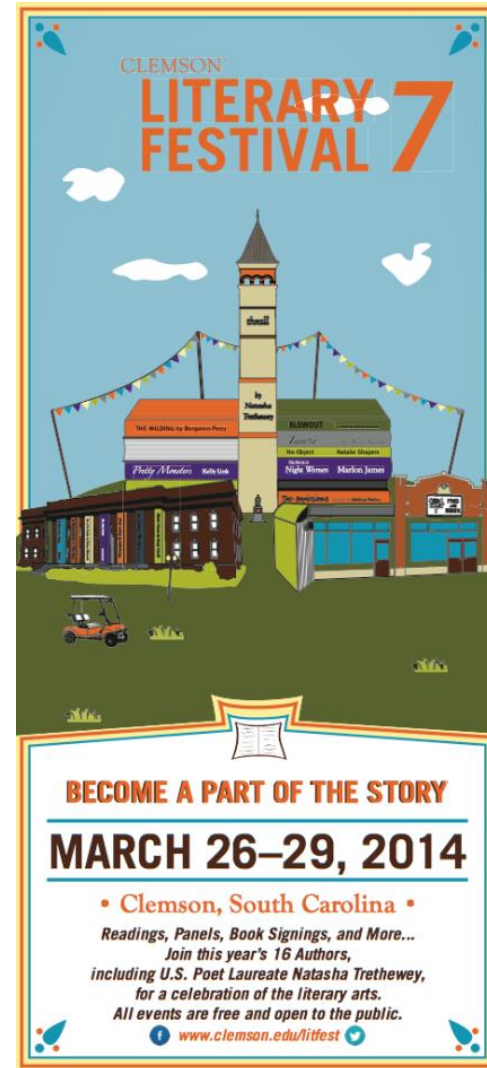
