Valdosta, GA-The Clemson Baseball Team opened the season on a losing note as they dropped a 6-2 decision to defending Division II Champion Valdosta State Friday afternoon.

Valdosta State jumped out to an early lead when, in the second inning, Pappy Sanchez hit a one-out double, Terry Reynolds lined a single and Rogers grounded out to score Sanchez.

In the bottom of the third, Carl Owen smashed a two-out homer making the score 2-0.

Clemson got on the scoreboard in the top of the fourth when Billy Weems doubled, went to third on a Robbie Allen ground out and scored when Tim Teufel also grounded out.

In the seventh inning, Jimmy Key came on to pitch, relieving Len Bradley (0-1). After one out, Key hit Joe Mederos. John Vunovich singled as did Frank de Gennaro. The latter single drove in Mederos. Then the big blow came as Andy Micacchione lined a two-out three-run homer, which increased the Valdosta lead to 6-1.

The final Clemson run came in the ninth when Teufel walked and scored on Frank Russ' second double of the afternoon.

The Tigers travel to Gainesville, Fla. Saturday to take on the Florida Gators. Game time is 1:30.

AINESVILLE, FLA.--Larry Mikesell of Florida let Clemson down on six hits here Monday afternoon as the Gators blanked the Tigers, 6-0, and sweep the two-game series. The loss drops Clemson to 0-3 on the season while Florida is now 3-2.

The shutout was the first one in 111 games for Clemson. Not since the Tigers were blanked in the last game of the 1977 College World Series have they failed to score.

Jimmy Key started for the Tigers and pitched two-hit ball for the first six innings. However, he was trailing 1-0 when he departed because of an unearned run in the first inning.

Len Bradley started pitching in the seventh and the Gators hopped on Bradley and three more pitchers in the inning for five runs, coming on seven hits, a walk, error, and passed ball.

After a walk started the inning, followed by a force out, the Gators got two successive hits off Bradley, Bill Duke came in and gave up two more, Bobby Kenyon was charged with two, and he fourth pitcher of the inning, Billy Trapp, gave up the seventh consecutive hit. The Gators sent 10 men to the plate during the inning.

Clemson had two hits in the sixth, but couldn't get anybody across and the Tigers had two more runners in the seventh with one out, but the final two batters went out. A two-out double by Robbie Allen, the only Tiger to get more than one hit went for naught in the eighth.

Key walked three and struck out three in his six innings while Mikesell fanned five and walked only one.

CLEMSON--Led by the hitting of Neil Simons, Bill Castelli, and Jimmy Key, the Clemson Tigers were able to overcome an early Georgia lead and go on to trounce the Bulldogs, 22-7. Through four and one-half innings the Tigers were behind 6-2. But a five run fifth inning and a 10 run eighth inning proved too much for Georgia. Mike Brown went the distance for the Tigers and evened his record at 1-1 for the season.

Simons tied a Clemson record for hits in a single game as he went 6-7. On the way, he two doubles and four singles and collected six RBI's. Bill Castelli was 4-4. He had a double, a triple, and two singles and knocked in four runs. Jimmy Key had a solo home run in the fourth and then knocked in three runs with a bases loaded double in the fifth inning.

In the fifth, Simons started it off with a single. After a two-base Georgia error and a walk, Key hit a shot to right field that scored all three runners. Weems singled and Castelli also singled to score both Key and Weems.

In the eighth, Castelli led off with a triple. Following a walk and a hit batter, Simons doubled, Robbie Allen tripled, Trent Grove singled, Castelli singled, Frank Russ singled, and Neil Simons singled to score the 10 runs in the inning.

Georgia jumped out to an early lead in the second inning when they scored two runs on two singles, a error by Clemson's Mike Brown, and a sacrifice fly. Georgia's other big inning was the fourth when Glenn Davis knocked a three run homer over the left field fence.

In recording his first victory of the season, Mike Brown struck out five and walked only one Georgia batter. Greg Morris was the losing pitcher. The win was the Tigers first this season. They are now 1-3. Clemson plays Western Carolina at 3:00 tomorrow at Clemson.

CLEMSON--East Tennessee's Buccaneers came into Tigertown for a three-game set on Friday and came away with a 3-2 thrilling victory under threatening skies. The Bucs got a three-run fourth frame to outlast the Tigers who scored both runs in the bottom of the ninth inning.

Catcher Ken Swinson led off the fourth for the Bucs drawing a walk from Clemson's Len Bradley. A long double by second baseman Mike Silber drove in Swinson with the game's first run. Rightfielder Bryan Snyder singled Silber to third and he scored on a ground ball to the Tiger infield.

The Tigers two runs in the ninth came on a walk by shortstop Frank Russ and a Greg Guin single and a RBI double by Bill Castelli. Guin scored on the throw into the dugout of the Bucs.

The next game for the Tigers is scheduled for Saturday at 2:00 pm and again Sunday at 2:00 pm with the same Buccaneer team, weather permitting.

Snyder and David Cardwell led the hitting for East Tennessee, with two apiece, while Guin was the only Tiger with more than one hit.

Bradley was tagged with the loss for the Tigers, while Jeff collected the win for East Tennessee. The game was the first of the season for the Bucs, 1-0, while the Tigers fall to 4-3.

A single by Neil Simons, doubles by Guin and David Lemaster, a hit batter and a single by Frank Russ produced three runs in the first, and the Tigers added another trio in the second, two coming on Guin's homer. A Danny Sheaffer triple and a single by Jay Sexton produced the final Tiger run in the ninth.

Catamounts' first baseman Don Ingle and left fielder Melvin E. Kinsey each had five hits apiece as Western Carolina pounded out 17 hits. The Cats had at least one hit in every inning.
