Governor Thurmond will deliver an address over a statewide network Wednesday evening, June 4. The time scheduled for individual stations throughout South Carolina is given below.

In his address the Governor will give a comprehensive summary of the legislation passed by the 1947 General Assembly and some legislation which he recommended in his Inaugural Address that was not enacted during the last session. Among topics he will discuss in some detail, will be the Liquor Question, dual office holding and the bill to reorganize the State Government.

Governor Thurmond's ideas in reference to the much discussed surplus fund bill, which is now awaiting his signature, will be set forth. This bill provides for the allocation of a major part of the existing State surplus to the higher educational institutions and for the establishment of a clinic-hospital at the Charleston Medical College. He has received a large number of letters and has interviewed many outstanding citizens in reference to this matter.
