(W. A. A) Purchases for State Institutions

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA HAS BEEN INFORMED BY THE WAR ASSETS ADMINISTRATION IN WASHINGTON THAT COUNTY AND CITY OWNED HOSPITALS AND NON-PROFIT HOSPITALS IN THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA ARE NOW ELIGIBLE TO PURCHASE EQUIPMENT NEEDED BY THE INSTITUTIONS WITHOUT A SYMBOL NUMBER FROM THE WAR ASSETS ADMINISTRATION ON A FAIR TRADE PRICE LESS 40% DISCOUNT. THE ONLY THING REQUIRED BY THE INSTITUTIONS MAKING THE PURCHASES IS TO CERTIFY THAT THE HOSPITAL IS A STATE, COUNTY, CITY OR NON-PROFIT INSTITUTION. THIS CERTIFICATION IS TO BE SHOWN ON THE FACE OF THE PURCHASE ORDER.
