From the list, six were determined as feasible and were either low or no cost. The six suggestions that were submitted to Lawrence Nichols for further development were:

- Flu shots for employees
- CPR training
- Approach Aramark about giving all employees a 10% discount upon presentation of valid id, similar to the discount given employees at the Barnes and Noble managed bookstore.
- Weekly or monthly lottery for a reserved parking spot
- Shut down the university between the Christmas and New Year holidays.
- Remind supervisors that flex-time is allowable.

Other ideas brought up during the meeting were the ability to pay Fike's fees by payroll deduction and compiling a list of local businesses that give discounts to university employees.
