

STATEMENT BY J. STROM THURMOND, GOVERNOR OF SOUTH CAROLINA,
ANNOUNCING THE APPOINTMENT OF MR. D. H. JOHNSON TO THE
LYLES-FORD TRI-COUNTY AUTHORITY, JULY 21, 1948

Governor J. Strom Thurmond announced today that he had appointed Dewey H. Johnson, President of the Bank of Greenwood, as a member of the Lyles-Ford Tri-County Power Authority, to succeed J. H. Hammond, resigned.

Mr. Johnson will serve as a member-at-large.

Governor Thurmond pointed out that Mr. Johnson is one of South Carolina's most prominent bankers. "He is a fine business man, and I feel certain that he will be a valuable addition to the membership of the Authority," the governor added. ##
