

STATEMENT BY J. STROM THURMOND, GOVERNOR OF
SOUTH CAROLINA ON SEPTEMBER 30, 1948, ON
BEHALF OF GOVERNOR FRANK CARLSON OF KANSAS

Governor J. Strom Thurmond, on behalf of Governor Frank Carlson of Kansas, wishes to invite all native Kansans, now residing in South Carolina, to return home for a visit at the time of the second annual Kansas Manufacturers Show at Wichita, October 19-24.

Governor Carlson states that he is sure that the former Kansans will be astonished at the progress their native state has made industrially in the last few years. They will be shown the largest plow in the world, the daintiest dryfly, airplanes, furnaces, tractors, many types of household, office, factory and farm equipment as well as processed mineral and farm products. More than 1,500 articles will be on display.
