NOW, THEREFORE, I, J. Strom Thurmond, Governor of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim the week, February 6 - February 12, 1948, as Boy Scout Week in South Carolina and urge all citizens to pay tribute to this splendid work which builds character and better citizenship.
