MR. PRESIDENT AND GENTLEMEN OF THE SENATE:

I am herewith returning to your Honorable Body Senate Bill No. 1064, House Bill No. 1403, and Act No. 751 entitled "TO PROVIDE FOR THREE (3) ADDITIONAL TRUSTEES FOR CAMERON SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 14 IN CALHOUN COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA, ONE EACH FROM CRESTON SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 12, CEDAR GROVE SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 11 AND NORTH LYONS SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 9 AND TO PROVIDE FOR THEIR ELECTION TO THE CAMERON SCHOOL BOARD".

This Act creates 3 additional trustees for Cameron School District No. 14 in Calhoun County, and not merely additional duties for the trustees selected from the other school districts to take part in the management of the school affairs of Cameron School District No. 14.

The Attorney General has advised me that, in his opinion, the Act is unconstitutional under the decision in the recent case of Ashmore et al. vs. Greater Greenville Sewer District et al., 211 S. C. 77, 44 S. E. (2d) 88. A copy of his opinion is attached hereto.

In view of the above I hereby veto this Act.
