SOUTH CAROLINA, MONDAY, FEBRUARY 9, 1948.

I have no details to add to what has already been published concerning the matters discussed at the meeting of the Southern Governors' Conference this weekend.

However, as Chairman of a special committee of the Conference, I am proceeding as rapidly as possible with the task of gathering and correlating the material and information necessary to develop and set in motion our program of action.
