

STATEMENT BY J. STROM THURMOND, GOVERNOR OF
SOUTH CAROLINA, CONCERNING THE SUGGESTION THAT
A SPECIAL SESSION OF THE LEGISLATURE IS NECESSARY,
AUGUST 13, 1948.

has asked me to call a special session of the General Assembly
for the purpose of enacting a general election law complying
with constitutional provisions.

I am giving serious study to this proposal, and will
have an announcement concerning it within a few days.
