STATEMENT BY J. STROM THURMOND, GOVERNOR OF
SOUTH CAROLINA, CONCERNING CONTINUATION OF
THE MATTER OF CONFIRMATION OF MISS FAITH
CLAYTON'S APPOINTMENT TO THE INDUSTRIAL
COMMISSION, MAY 25, 1949.

The majority of the Senate stood for confirming Miss Faith Clayton throughout a tiresome ordeal, and they are to be commended. Since her character and qualifications are unquestioned and unchallenged, Miss Clayton was entitled to immediate confirmation, and I regret that her confirmation will be delayed until next year.
