

STATEMENT BY J. STROM THURMOND, GOVERNOR OF SOUTH CAROLINA, ANNOUNCING THE APPOINTMENT OF MR. WILSON W. HARRIS OF CLINTON, AS A MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS OF THE SOUTH CAROLINA STATE HOSPITAL. DECEMBER 2, 1949.

I have appointed Mr. Wilson W. Harris of Clinton as a member of the Board of Regents of the South Carolina State Hospital to succeed Mr. R. L. Plaxico of Clinton, who recently resigned.

Mr. Harris is Editor of the CLINTON CHRONICLE and a past President of the South Carolina Press Association.

He was instrumental in the establishment of the State Training School at Clinton, serving on the original Chamber of Commerce Committee in 1918 which helped raise the funds to purchase the land for the State Training School. I am confident that Mr. Harris's long experience and great abilities render him capable of outstanding service to our State as a member of the Board of Regents of the South Carolina State Hospital.

I feel that our State is fortunate to secure the services of Mr. Harris.
