(National Reorganization Month)

WHEREAS, the growth of our nation, its increased participation in world affairs and the need of servicing our people better has brought an inevitable enlargement of our federal government; and

WHEREAS, our prosperity, security and strength -- in fact, our very freedom -- depend in no small measure on the efficiency of our federal government; and

WHEREAS, over many years, studies have shown the possibility of achieving greater efficiency, effectiveness and economical management through the reorganization of our federal government; and

WHEREAS, the interest, understanding and support of our citizens are vital to the accomplishment of any effective program of reorganization;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, J. Strom Thurmond, Governor of the State of South Carolina, do hereby designate May 1 to May 31, 1950 as National Reorganization Month, and urge our people to observe this period with ceremonies and activities designed to increase interest and knowledge of the possibilities of reorganization and its benefits to the country and our state.
