STATEMENT BY SENATOR STROM THURMOND (D-SC) ON PUBLIC HEARING
ON PROPOSALS FOR GI PEACETIME BENEFITS, MARCH 5, 1957

As Chairman of the Subcommittee on Veterans' Affairs of the Committee on Labor and Public Welfare, I wish to announce that hearings will begin Monday, March 18, on bills amending or extending the provisions of the Veterans' Readjustment Assistance Act of 1952, the so-called Korean G. I. Bill of Rights, as follows: S. 166, 667, 714, 1061, 1095, 1129, 1158 and 1282, and related bills which may subsequently be introduced and referred to the Subcommittee. Officials of the Veterans' Administration^{tion} have been invited to be the first witnesses at the hearings to be held at 10:00 A.M., Monday, March 18, in the Old Supreme Court Chamber, Room P. 63, in the Capitol.

It is requested that all persons wishing to appear before the Subcommittee to present testimony on these bills make application to Mr. Stewart E. McClure, Chief Clerk of the Senate Committee on Labor and Public Welfare, as soon as possible.
