

TELEVISION FILM-CLIP OF SENATOR STROM THURMOND, MAY 31, 1957

I regret that Great Britain has again acted without co-ordination with the United States by recognizing Red China for trade purposes.

The United States should not enter into trade with communist China even though Britain has approved such action. Approval of trading with communist China is to me the placing of economic considerations above moral principle.

This country should continue to prohibit trading with Red China until the communists of that country release every prisoner of the United Nations, and until a peace treaty is secured in Korea.
