Senator Thurmond announced today he will renew his efforts to have the Congress approve S. 267, a bill which would freeze cotton acreage allotments at 17.5 million acres on a permanent basis. Senator Thurmond is co-sponsoring with Senator Stennis and others.

He also co-sponsored last year legislation which made it mandatory for the Secretary of Agriculture to freeze the acreage allotment for the 1958 crop at the same level.
