STATEMENT BY SENATOR STROM THURMOND (D-SC) FOR SOUTH CAROLINA NEWSPAPERS, FEBRUARY 28, 1958

I have been in contact with key members of the Agriculture Subcommittee of the Senate Appropriations Committee regarding the administration of the Soil Bank Plan in South Carolina.

Because of the assurances these Senators have given me, I am ~~now willing to~~ predict that a ~~supplemental~~ supplemental Soil Bank appropriation of \$250,000,000 will be ~~recommended to~~ ^{approved by} the ~~Senate~~ ^{Congress}. This is the maximum amount authorized for the Soil Bank program.

I will continue to give full support to this appropriation, which represents a moral obligation of the government. When the matter comes to the Senate floor, I expect to present my position in detail in an address.
